



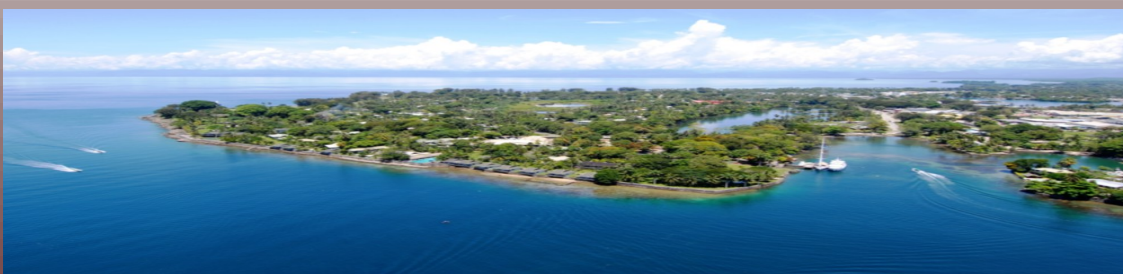



A further outcome will be the identification for governments of issues which business groups in each country regard as requiring government policy or administrative action to facilitate bilateral business and investment growth.
